



BASIC BIRD CARE

DO

- Wash water and food bowls at least daily.
- Provide companion bird seed (not wild bird seed), pellets, fruit and vegetables -if in doubt try fresh or defrosted peas and sweetcorn, fresh bell peppers, banana (peeled) and apple.
- Make sure perches, toys and the cage are clean and change the paper at the bottom of the cage daily.
- Provide company and entertainment such as a radio or TV.
- Ensure the bird can't escape out of open windows / doors.
- Call for expert help and advice if needed.

DO NOT

- Use bleach, upholstery and other toxic cleaning products anywhere in the vicinity of the birds - the fumes alone may kill them.
- Use Teflon type non-stick equipment in the vicinity of the birds.
- Smoke, spray perfume, hair spray or other aerosols, use candles or room scents / fresheners in the vicinity of the birds.
- Feed alcohol, caffeine, chocolate, crisps, monkey nuts.
- Let birds out of cage, in the same space as a dog or cat.
